Order of Business:

- 3. Sigma Tau Delta Mentoring Program. Will explore the possibility of hosting a lunch and learn mentoring meeting for both interested undergraduate mentees and graduate mentors. Under the larger umbrella of the mentorship program, will also host larger workshops that deal with CV design and resumes. Need to design a clear list of program goals in order to recruit mentors. By September 12^{th,} will have a draft finished of the external facing proposal to recruit graduate mentors.
